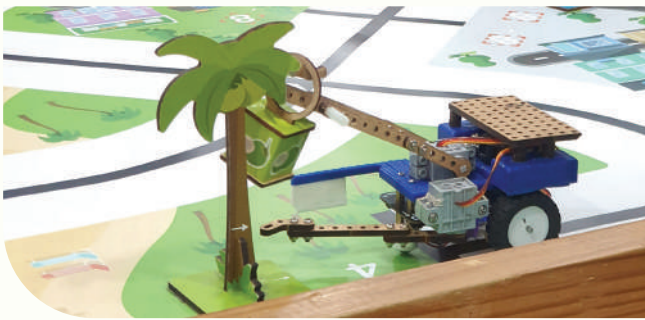


Track 2

Mohammed H. Khan, India Building Technology With Heart

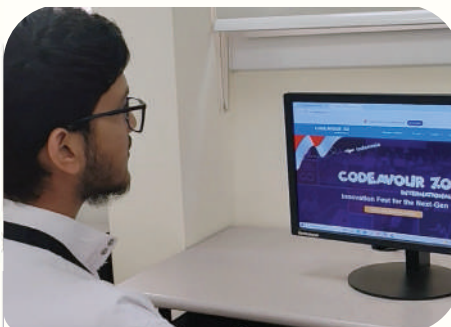
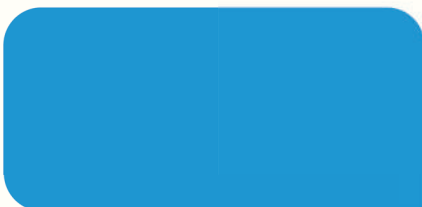
Mohammed Hasen Khan, a Grade 7 student from Karnataka, is a young achiever known for his powerful voice, confidence, and versatility. Recognized as a “**Master Orator**,” he was awarded by the **Indian Book of Records** for delivering speeches in three languages, earning recognition across public speaking, martial arts, stage performance, and innovation.

His Codeavour journey began with a simple thought: no elderly person should face loneliness without support. Guided by empathy and technology, Mohammed built a solution to bring care, connection, and comfort to senior citizens. After representing Karnataka at the **India Nationals** at GITAM (Deemed to be University), he proudly advanced to Codeavour 7.0 Internationals, representing India on an international scale.

Under the FSEF Impact Program, students began their coding journey through self-paced PictoBlox courses, guided by **Teacher Ambassador Ms. Poonam** and supported by **ICT Coordinator Begum Sufiya**. Encouraged by the school management, they explored coding, robotics, and project-based learning. Some students also developed an ingenious app concept aimed at improving accessibility for specially-abled students, demonstrating how technology can inspire meaningful community-focused innovation.

Dikshant Pandey's impressive journey beautifully shows how Codeavour can become a massive turning point for young innovators. Her innovation-driven journey also led to admission offers from prestigious institutions, including **Yale University** and the **University of Toronto**, as she continues to inspire young minds.

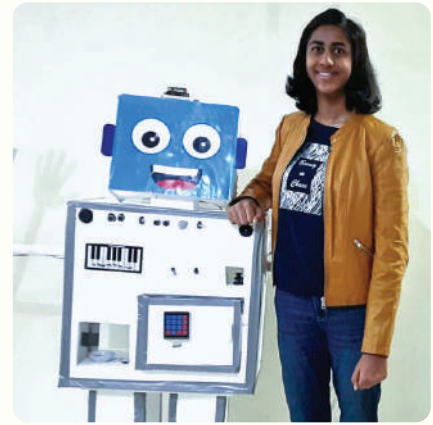
A Journey That Came Full Circle

Young Haryana Girls Achieve Excellence With Real-World Solutions

Codeavour's school-level events reached 50 government schools across 13 districts of Haryana, engaging 20,000+ students in hands-on STEM learning. Students showcased meaningful projects, from assistive blind sticks to a **Smart Ventilator System** designed to support patients

facing breathing difficulties through controlled airflow and programmed breathing cycles. The journey reached a proud global milestone when **Prachi, 15, and Harshita, 16, won the Girls in STEM Award** at the International Showdown in Jakarta, Indonesia, standing out amongst 265 teams.



From Valleys To Global Stage, Himachal Pradesh Students Shine Through

In association with the **Samagra Shiksha** initiative under the **Government of Himachal Pradesh**, Codeavour helped organize the **State STEM Hackathon**, creating opportunities for students to apply innovation to real-world challenges. association with Third Assalam School, and on-ground orientations across **35+ schools** helped students experience technology as something they could build and explore.

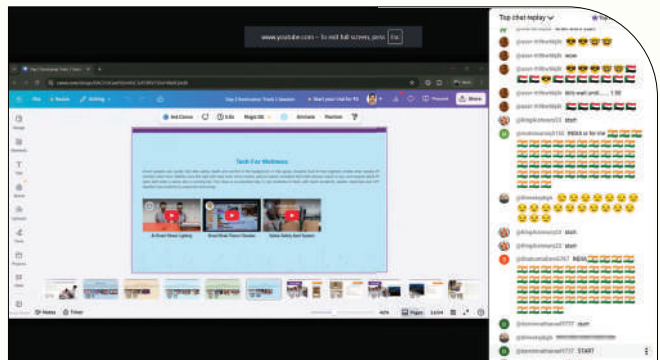
